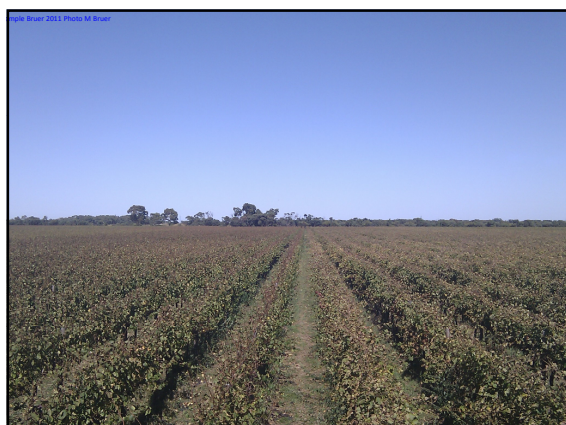


## Vintage 2017 The Fungal Trifecta

Powdery Downey and Botrytis

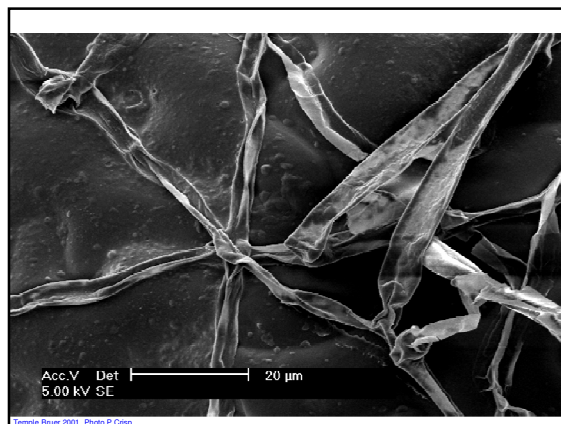
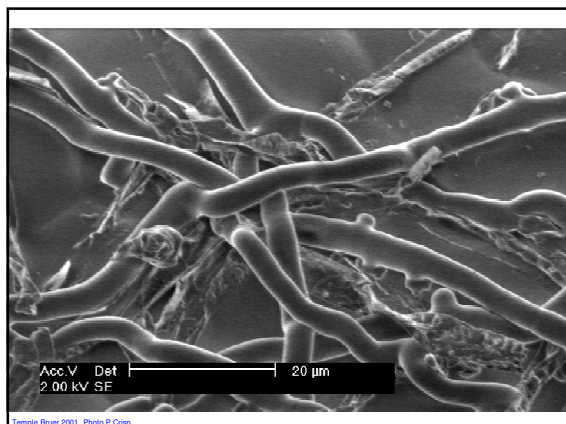
The coming vintage, 2017, is shaping up to be a vintage from hell.



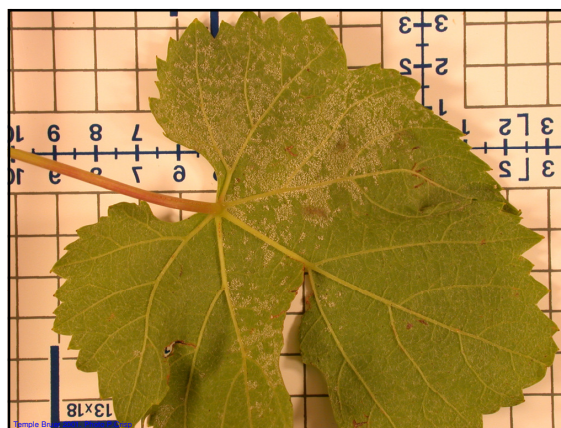
Powdery mildew, usually the most serious, easy to control early with a vegetable oil and bicarb.

This spray needs a minimum of six hours of bright sunlight to work





Downey mildew, can be very serious  
with rain events seven to ten days  
apart  
It lives inside the vine tissue



**Botrytis cinerea – more usually  
known as bunch rot.**

Very serious with rain around  
harvest. Can go from 3% to 100%  
infection in seven days.
